- Technology & Knowledge Management (Mushroom Cultivation, 5 MT Cold Chamber, Banana & Honeybee Cultivation)

Financial Support by OMBADC- Rs. 79.56 Cr

Provisions in the scheme:

- Beneficiaries selected are women headed households with children less than five years, Pregnant & lactating women
- Each beneficiary gets financial support of Rs.1000/- for preparing plot for Nutri-garden and a seed kit
- Seed kit contains 13 types of vegetable seeds for Kharif season & 17 type of seeds for Rabi season
- Convergence with MGNREGS to promote livelihood opportunities among rural poor.

Success Story 1- Mushroom Cultivation

Name - Smt. Madhusmita Mahanta

She has successfully set up her mushroom cultivation unit of Rs. 2 Lakhs with help of Department of Horticulture under the OMBADC funded Scheme - 2020-2021. She has undertaken training from the Dept. of Horticulture on production of mushroom and is successful entrepreneur in her own might. Mrs. Mahanta produces mushroom through her permanent unit round the year.

As she runs a successful business on her own, she has been provided with Mushroom spawn Production unit under OMBADC (Through DDH, Keonjhar) for furthering her mushroom business. Earlier they had to bring spawn from Bhubaneswar as sometimes KVK was unable to supply the required quantum of spawn.



Success Story 3 - Mushroom Production Unit

Mr. Amar Mohakud was struggling to meet his daily needs during COVID-19 pandemic. His only source of income was driving which had to be discontinued due to the strict COVID protocols. He had been selected as a beneficiary by the Deputy Director of Horticulture, Mayurbhanj, Baripada in due selection process and was able to set a Mushroom production unit under OMBADC scheme in 2021-22. The scheme assistance has made him capable to build a permanent structure with three-layer bamboo racks with capacity of total 600 beds in rotation per month and he now earns Rs 30000/month.
