- (NPV) recovered by the State of Odisha from the mining lessees will be used by the State of Odisha through a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for undertaking specific tribal welfare and area development works so as to ensure inclusive growth of the mineral bearing areas. The State of Odisha will accordingly file within four weeks from today, a comprehensive plan for the development of tribals out of the aforesaid funds, taking into consideration their requirements of health, education, communication, recreation, livelihood and cultural life style as indicated in this Court's judgment in T.N. Godavaraman Thirumulpad Vs. Union Of India & Others (2008) 2 SCC 222.
 - 2. The Paragraph (iii) (b) of the Guidelines for diversion of forest land for non forest purposes under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in the circular dated 1st February, 2013 of the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests, FC
